



The New Lawful You

Your emotions are the functional indicators of your true belief system at the moment.

They are <u>not</u> your identity. They are <u>your location</u>.

Keys to Overcoming

- 1. Know the new lawful you is your true identity.
- 2. You will have to speak the truth to yourself.
- 3. Understand that the old self will try to enforce the old self system on the new you.

Cognitive Dissonance

What is cognitive dissonance?

Cognitive – <u>Conscious mental activities</u> such as thinking, understanding, learning and remembering which includes knowing, perceiving, and judgments as opposed to emotional and willful actions. (**awareness**)

Dissonance – <u>Lack of agreement</u> especially inconsistency between the beliefs one holds or <u>between ones actions and ones beliefs</u>.

Law of Mimicry

You can't do what you don't know. You can only do what you've been taught, what you caught, or what's been demonstrated to you.

You learn by what you see and hear. <u>All</u> of your information that you have, came from outside of yourself. You learn this behavior by mimicking your mother while a baby.

Law of Agreement

Agreement is accepting information outside of yourself knowingly or unknowingly and integrating it into one's belief systems.

You consent by default when you don't know that you have the responsibility to discern the information presented to you. This is based on ones maturity level.

Law of Mimicry & Agreement

You become what you submit to knowingly or unknowingly and your behavior demonstrates your agreement with what you were taught, caught, or demonstrated.

Your emotions are a reflection of your learned belief system. This makes up your basic operating system and the 90% subconscious part of you

Awareness


Taking responsibility for your awareness
