

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God's Threefold Plan for Salvation

- 2 Corinthians 1:9-10 ⁹ But we had the sentence of death in ourselves, that we should not trust in ourselves, but in God which raiseth the dead:
- ¹⁰ Who delivered us from so great a death, and doth deliver:

in whom we trust that **he will yet deliver** us;

Paul is clearly speaking of deliverance in a past, present and future context

What does Justification Mean?

- Legal term meaning :
 - To be declared just, innocent, or righteous in the eyes of the law

Does becoming a "son of God" happen at the start of the end of the Salvation Journey ?

@Beginning:

- 1 John 3:2-3 Beloved, <u>now are we</u> <u>the sons of God</u>,
- <mark>Sons = Gr.5043 **teknon**</mark>
 - Meaning mature child
 - not yet an adult

VS.

@Destination:

- Romans 8:19 For the earnest expectation of the creature <u>waiteth</u> for the manifestation of the sons of God.
- <mark>Sons = Gr. 5207 **huios,**</mark>
 - Meaning mature adult son

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What is Imputation?

Imputation:

Declaring something "that is not" ... as if it "were"

Courtroom Analogy





- Prisoner in transition to freedom
 - Chains removed
 - Personal effects returned

- Prisoner receives declaration of innocence
 - Imputed freedom since handcuffs and leg irons are still applied



- Manifested freedom
 - When actual release from the prison has been realized
 - All imputed promises have been fulfilled


Imputation of Fatherhood and Righteousness for Abraham

• Romans 4:17-18

¹⁷ (As it is written, I have made thee a father of many nations,) before him whom he believed, *even* God, who quickeneth the dead, and calleth those things which be not as though they were.

• Romans 4:19-22

²⁰ He (Abraham) staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; but was strong in faith, giving glory to God; ²¹ And being **fully persuaded that, what he** *(God)* **had promised, he was able also to perform**. ²² And <u>therefore</u> <u>it was imputed to him for</u> <u>righteousness</u>.



Abraham received imputed fatherhood and...

... his belief, that God would fulfill his promises, was imputed to him as righteousness!

What is Manifestation?


Manifestation:

- An indication of the existence, reality, or presence of something
- The actual realization of an anticipated state, action, or condition.

Manifestation of Fatherhood and Righteousness for Abraham


- Fatherhood was manifested for Abraham through the birth of his sons Ishmael and Isaac, along with his six sons with Keturah.
 - Over the centuries, the earth has been filled with many nations of people descended from Abraham's sons
 - Hebrews 11:39-40

³⁹ And these all, having obtained a good report through faith, <u>received not the promise</u>:
⁴⁰ God having provided some better thing for us, that **they** without us should not be made perfect.



Abraham's imputed fatherhood has already become a manifestation ...

... but the manifestation of his imputed righteousness will not happen ahead of the New Covenant Believers.



- **1 John 3:2** "<u>Now</u> we are the sons (Gr. *teknon*) of God ..."
- Romans 8:19 "For the anxious longing of the creation waits eagerly for the revealing of the sons (Gr. *huios*) of God"

Imputed Righteousness in The New Covenant

Romans 4:23-25 ²³ Now it was not written for his (*Abraham's*) sake alone, that it was imputed to him; ²⁴ **But for us also, to whom it shall be imputed, if we believe on** <u>him that raised up Jesus our Lord from the dead</u>; ²⁵ Who was delivered for our offences and <u>was raised again for our justification</u>.

If we Believe (as Abraham did) that God is able to fulfill His New Covenant Promises, then righteousness shall be imputed to us as it was to Abraham!! 18 © Copyright 2023 - - Rob Corry

"The Leading of ... vs "The Gift of ... "

- 1 Corinthians 12:3 states that "... no man can say that Jesus is Lord except by the Holy Spirit."
- When the people were convicted in their hearts by the Spirit-led teaching of the disciples on the Day of Pentecost ... they asked Peter, "what should we do" and he said:

- Acts 2:37-38

Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit

 Based on 1 Corinthians 12:3, the conviction of their hearts was brought about by the Leading of the Holy Spirit ... but ... the "Gift of the Holy Spirit" was received after repentance and baptism.

We are led by the Holy Spirit before we receive the "Gift of the Holy Spirit"

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In the Context of Salvation, "the Gift of the Holy Spirit" is SO MORE than being led by the Spirit !!

The Role of the Holy Spirit

The Role of the Holy Spirit

Belief of the Truth that leads us to Christ and establishes faith within us

Belief / Faith

- The Holy Spirit Leads us to Believe in Jesus ... our belief is a gift:
 - Philippians 1:29 "For unto you <u>it is given in the</u> behalf of Christ, not only <u>to believe on him</u>, …"
 - 2 Thessalonians 2:13 : " <u>God hath from</u> the beginning <u>chosen you to salvation through</u> sanctification of the Spirit and <u>belief of the truth</u>"
 - Ephesians 2:8 For by grace are ye<u>saved</u>
 <u>through faith</u>, and that <u>not of yourselves</u>, it is the <u>gift of God</u>

Our Belief in Christ is given to us by God through the revelation of Truth by the Holy Spirit

Repentance

- 2 Timothy 2:24-25 ²⁴ And the Lord's bond-servant must not be quarrelsome, but be kind to all, able to teach, patient when wronged, ²⁵ with gentleness correcting those who are in opposition, <u>if perhaps</u> <u>God may grant them repentance</u> leading to the knowledge of the truth,
- 2 Peter 3:9 The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing (G1014 boulomai / planning) that any should perish, but that ALL should come to repentance.
- 1 Timothy 2:2-4 : ³For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Saviour; ⁴ Who <u>will (G2309,</u> Thelo / desires) have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth.

God's Desire is that ALL will be saved, and He accomplishes that desire with a sovereign plan that has people resist that desire for a season but in the end, all are brought to repentance By the revelation of Truth, the Holy Spirit convicts our hearts and moves us to repent (change of thoughts and feelings) 21


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Begotten of the Spirit

- John 3:5-6 ⁵ Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born (*G1080, gennao,: begotten*) of water and *of* the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.
- ⁶ That which is born (*begotten*) of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born (*begotten*) of the Spirit is spirit.
 - Colossians 1:26-27 Even the mystery which hath been hid from ages and from generations, but now is made manifest to his saints: ²⁷ To whom God would make known what *is* the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the hope of glory:

In Justification, we are begotten by the word of Truth revealed in us by the indwelling of the Holy Spirit

The Role of the Holy Spirit in Justification



Adop ion of Sons



Paul refers to the Holy Spirit as the "Spirit of Adoption" Romans 8:15-17 ¹⁵ For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father. ¹⁶ The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children (Gr. teknon) of God: ¹⁷And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and jointheirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with *him*, that we may be also glorified together.

CREATION GROANS

"God's Adoption Process"

- is completed in the manifestation of the Sons of God
 - WHICH IS: the redemption of our bodies
- Romans 8:22-23 ²² For we know that the whole creation groaneth and travaileth in pain together until now. ²³ And not only *they*, but ourselves also, which have the firstfruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, waiting for the adoption, *to wit (i.e., which is)*, <u>the redemption of our body.</u>



"Under the Law" Means under the Judgment of the Law which is the death sentence of "mortality" **Galatians 4:4-5** ⁴ But when the fulness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law, ⁵ To redeem them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons.

Traffic Analogy to Explain "under the Law"

- If you come to a complete stop, the policeman will not "arrest your progress" by "applying the law" as there was no violation.
 - But the Law still exists
- If you blow through the stop sign the officer will "arrest your progress" by pulling you over
 - If he gives you a citation, you will be "under the judgment of the law until the fine is paid
 - If he gives you a warning, then you will move from "under the law" to "under mercy"
- If you receive the citation, but your friend offers to pay the fine for you, then you move from "under the law" to "under Grace"
 But again, the traffic laws all still exist ... it's just your legal status that is changing
- If your friend offers to pay all of your traffic citations past, present and future, ... Then you would be "under grace" as a permanent state
 Should you continue to violate the laws since you are under grace? GOD FORBID (Romans 6:15)!

Under the Law means: "under the application, or Judgment of the Law



Adam's Death Sentence passed to all Men or UNFAIR Y

Not a question of fairness it's genetics!

Adam became mortal and that defect was genetically passed to all those who were "begotten" of his mortal flesh.

 Romans 5:12 Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; <u>and so death passed</u> <u>upon all men</u>, for that all have sinned.

ESUS HRIST

Qualified to Redeem us as he had no sin debt to pay of his own!

Jesus' sinless condition qualified him to be the "perfect / unblemished lamb" whose sacrifice would serve as the propitiation for our sins

- **1 John 3:5** And ye know that he was manifested to take away our sins; and in him is no sin.
- 1 John 2:2 And He (*Jesus*) is the propitiation for our sins: and not for ours only, but also for *the sins of* the whole world.

For sin shall not have dominion over you: for ye are not under the law, but under grace. Romans 6:14

Jesus' act of redemption was the legal pre-requisite for the Holy Spirit to come that we might receive the adoption of sons (huiothesia) ... which is the redemption of our bodies (Romans 8:23) Galatians 4:4-5 ⁴ But when the fulness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law, ⁵ To redeem them that were under the law, <u>that we might receive the</u> <u>adoption of sons.</u>

The Redemption of our Bodies <u>is</u> the resurrection of our Glorified Bodies

Romans 8:23 ²² we know that the whole creation groaneth and travaileth in pain together until now. ²³ And not only *they*, but ourselves also, which have the firstfruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, waiting for the adoption, *to wit (i.e., which is)*, the redemption of our body.
